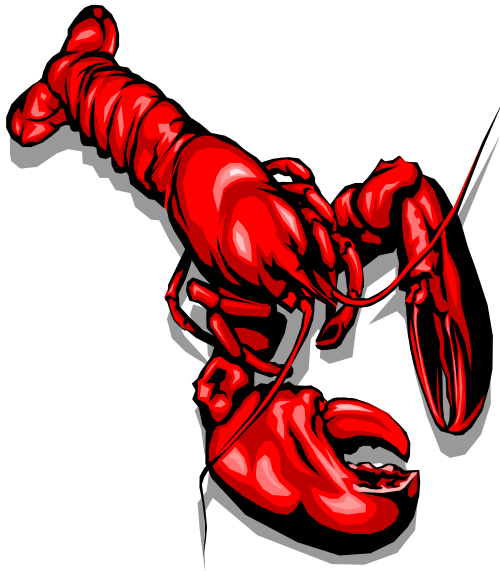

Directions to Shore Acres Club

159 Shore Drive, Brick, NJ

By Car:

GSP South

Take **exit 89** Brick/Lakewood

Make first **Right** towards Lakewood/Brick

Make next **Right** onto CR-528/Cedar Bridge Rd towards Brick

Go seven lights, make **Right** onto Old Hooper Ave. (Villa Victoria Rest. on left)

Go to first light; make **Left** onto Drum Point Rd. (at Walgreen's)

Turn **Right** onto Adair St (ninth street past third light)

Cross over Bay View Dr., bear **Left** at fork, follow to end.

Turn **Left** onto Shore Dr.

Clubhouse is at end of Shore Drive-park along street

GSP North

Take **exit 90**

Make **Right** onto Chambers Bridge Road, which then becomes Old Hooper Ave. on far side of Rt. 70

Continue to go straight ; make **Left** onto Drum Point Rd. (at Walgreen's)

Turn **Right** onto Adair St (ninth street past third light)

Cross over Bay View Dr., bear **Left** at fork, follow to end.

Turn **Left** onto Shore Dr.

Clubhouse is at end of Shore Drive - park along street

By Boat:

Lat 40° 01' 16.08N Lon 74° 06' 29.11W Kettle Creek is on the mainland side of Barnegat Bay just opposite Chadwick Beach, between the Metedeconk River and Silver Bay. The entrance to Kettle Creek is .9 nm NW of Green buoy "21" on the ICW. Keep to the center of the entrance; there is a sandbar on the far Left (W) side. The clubhouse and anchorage are .5 nm NW of the entrance (just past the second lagoon entrance on the **Right**). It is **NOT** the first clubhouse on the Right (with a cupola on the roof).
