Driving Directions: From Garden State Parkway Southbound, take Exit 117 to Route 36 East. Follow for approximately 12 miles to Linden Avenue (see signs for ferry to NYC). Take the jug handle for a left hand turn and follow Linden Avenue downhill to the stop sign. Bear left onto Waterwitch Avenue and take the first left onto Shore Drive. Follow Shore Drive to the stop sign and turn right onto Willow Street. Marina parking available and marked.

By Boat From the tip of Sandy Hook: steer a course of 180 to Red Buoy #6. Turn up to 120 and look for the entrance to Sandy Hook Bay Marina approximately 100' beyond the trailer park on starboard.
