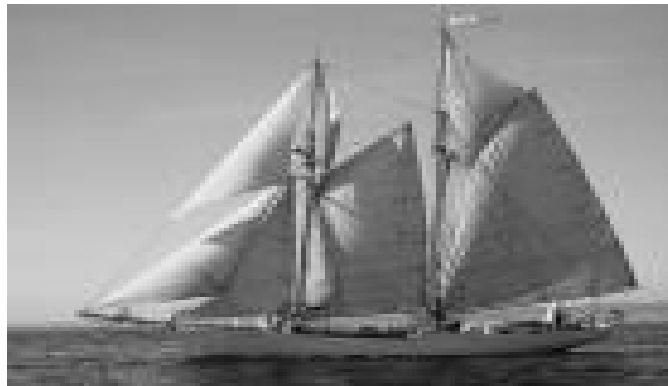

*This 75 foot, two masted gaff rigged schooner was built in 1902. The ship will sail the New York Harbor, Hudson River, and pass by the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island. Passengers may also bring additional cold food and liquor.*
