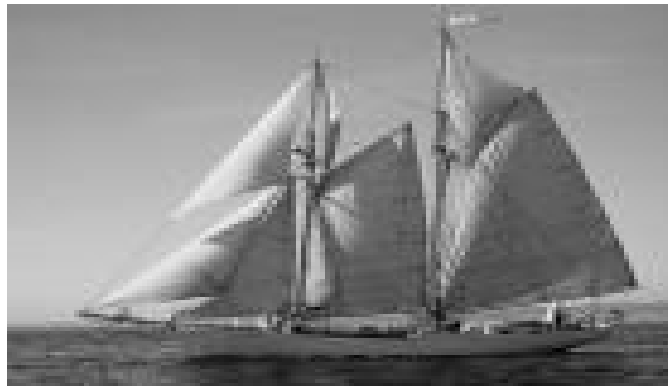


Lackawanna Sail & Power Squadron
